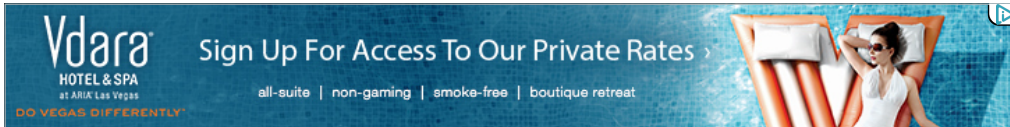

### Full Definition of *elf*

*plural elves* [play](#) \ˈelvz\

1. *l* : a small often mischievous fairy
2. *l* : a small lively creature; *also* : a usually lively mischievous or malicious person

**elf-ish** [play](#) \ˈel-fish\ *adjective*

**elf-ish-ly** *adverb*
